YOUR STORM WATER FEES AT WORK

Dear Resident:

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services has hired engineering consultant Parson Brinckerhoff, Inc. and surveyor Dewberry Engineers, Inc. to study possible drainage improvements in the Cutchin Drive project area. The project is bordered by Sharon View Road to the north, Wamath Drive and Mountainbrook Road to the south, McMullen Creek to the east and Sharon Road to the west.

Survey work has been completed and the existing conditions engineering analysis has begun. Once the analysis is complete, a public meeting will be held to receive input from residents on how the engineering

models compare with what has been observed by those living in the area. Meeting details will be mailed to residents approximately two weeks in advance.
