The project goals are to update the existing infrastructure, reduce the flooding in structures and streets, increase channel capacity and reduce erosion.

#### Meeting highlights:

- Project Manager Greg Cole introduced the project team and gave a presentation on the project history, boundaries and how the Edgewater project was selected.
- Cole explained the phases: planning, design, real estate, bid and construction. The project is in the planning phase.
- The engineering consultant for this project is US Infrastructure Of Carolina (USI).

- USI reviewed the results of the stormwater modeling.
- A question and answer session was held.
- Three break-out groups answered specific questions.
