Dear Resident:

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant US Infrastructure of Carolina, Inc., have completed study of the existing primary storm drainage system in the First Ward area. This system begins at the East 8th/North Caldwell intersection and discharges into a channel near the intersection of North McDowell Street and the East 6th Street ramp exiting I-277.

The goal of the study was to identify any system deficiencies and propose improvements to address them. We discovered that the portion of the drainage system that runs through the First Ward Place Apartments appears to be at the end of its service life and may require replacement. We are currently working with the property owners to determine what storm drainage

improvements are needed. The proposed improvements begin at the First Ward Place Apartments driveway off of North Davidson Street and end at the intersection of North Alexander Street and Parkside Terrace Lane. This will be the final mailer to all residents not in the direct vicinity of these proposed improvements.
