Dear Resident,

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and consulting engineer, Armstrong Glen, continue to work on the Gaynor Storm Drainage Improvement Project. Easement acquisition and the final design plans are complete.

The bid phase should begin in June. During the bid phase, the final plans will be circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process. By state law, the lowest responsible bidder is awarded the construction contract. The bid phase typically lasts 6

months. Construction is anticipated to begin in 2015.
