Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and Sealand Contractors Corporation continue with the construction phase. The project is on budget and on schedule with about 50% of the work complete.

The contractor will lay the remaining box culvert in Gaynor Avenue and the system will turn towards the backs of the homes. The contractor will finish laying the pipe behind the homes, and then progress to the other

leg of the storm drainage system down Chillingworth Lane.

Please do not park on the street during milling and resurfacing of the streets where the storm drainage is already completed. You will have access to your driveway during this time, but you may have to alert the contractor that you need to leave and allow them time to move their equipment.

Temporary construction traffic signage will direct motorists around the construction work zones. Please follow the detour signs and be alert for workers in the construction zone.
