Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and consultant engineer, Parsons-Brinkerhoff, Inc., began the design phase in March for the Greenhaven/Pierson Drive Storm Drainage Improvement Project.

Design work includes locating utilities, verifying pipe clearances, creating computer generated maps and resolving any utility/pipe conflicts. Once 70% plans have been submitted and reviewed, a public meeting will be held to present the design to the public. The goals are to improve storm drainage

infrastructure, reduce street and structure flooding, and reduce erosion.
