Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and consulting engineer, Parsons-Brinkerhoff, Inc., continue with the design phase.

Design work includes locating utilities, verifying pipe clearances, creating computer generated maps and resolving any utility/pipe conflicts. Preliminary design plans have been submitted by the consultant and are being reviewed by City staff. Once all comments have been addressed, a public meeting will be held to present the design to the public.

The goals of this project are to improve storm drainage infrastructure, reduce street and structure flooding, and reduce erosion.
