Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services held its second public meeting on November 12 at Eastern Hills Baptist Church to present the existing conditions for the Greenhaven Storm Drainage Improvement Project.

Meeting highlights:

- Project Manager Harold Smith introduced the project team and consultants. Smith then presented a brief overview of the project and the selected alternative. The selected alternative will create a by-pass system that will run down Wienfield Drive and Greenhaven Lane and then have its own outfall into the Pierson Drive pond. Additional catch basins will be added along Pierson Drive.

- Karl Dauber, Project Manager for our design consultant Parsons-Brinckerhoff, explained the technical aspects of the selected alternative. The by-pass system from Winfield Drive to Pierson pond will remove flow out of the main creek which will allow the current culvert under Pierson Drive to function better.
- A question/answer session was held.
