Project Status

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant Parsons Brinckerhoff, Inc. have finalized the construction plans and begun the bid phase. During this phase, the final design plans will be circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process.

Next Steps

After City Council approval, the construction contract is awarded to the lowest responsible bidder. Construction is expected to begin in late summer and last approximately 12 to 14 months, but may be completed faster.
