Dear Resident,

The survey portion of the Greenhaven/Pierson Drive Project has been completed and reviewed. The project area boundaries are Pierson Drive to the north and east, Albemarle Road to the south, and Independence Boulevard to the west.

Consulting engineers with Parsons Brinkerhoff Inc., are analyzing the project area's existing drainage conditions. Once review of the analysis is complete, a public meeting will be scheduled to present the findings and solicit input from property owners. Notification of time and location will be mailed to you two weeks in advance of the meeting.
