Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services has selected a new engineering consultant, WK Dickson & Associates, to complete the design phase of the project. The previously submitted preliminary design plans are being updated. When this is complete, a public meeting will be held to present the preliminary design plans for feedback and to initiate the easement acquisition phase. A mailer will be sent to residents regarding the time and place of this meeting. Meeting details will be mailed to residents approximately two weeks in advance.
