Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services is reviewing the design alternatives of the Hill Street Storm Drainage Improvement Project. Once the review is complete a preferred design alternative will be chosen and presented at a public meeting where an open discussion regarding the impacts will take place. The public meeting will be important because property owners will hear how their flooding issues will be addressed. Meeting details will be mailed to residents approximately two weeks prior to the meeting.
