Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and consulting engineer, Armstrong Glen, P.C. are working on the design phase. Additional survey and other information is needed to design the improvements.

Representatives from Armstrong Glen; their stream specialist, Wildlands; their surveyor, Survey & Mapping Control, Inc.; or their geotechnical specialist, Boyle Consulting Engineers, PLLC may need to enter your property to collect survey data on the existing storm drainage system. While State law authorizes access to private property for this purpose, no buildings or structures will be entered or disturbed.
