Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services is finalizing the survey work for the Hinsdale/Tinkerbell Storm Drainage Improvement Project. Additional survey may be needed in the future.

During the following months, Armstrong Glen will be preparing the existing conditions analysis for the City to review. When that analysis is complete, a public meeting will be scheduled to present the findings and solicit input from residents and property owners. A notification with time and location will be mailed to you two weeks in advance of the meeting.

You may have noticed the City making emergency

repairs to the culvert under Champaign Street earlier this month. A City crew found the problems while performing routine maintenance.
