



We are in the process of acquiring easements needed to build the improvements. Once easement acquisition is complete, we will finalize the construction drawings and then begin the bid phase. During this phase, the final design plans will be circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process. After City Council approval, the construction contract is awarded to the lowest responsible bidder.
