Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant, Armstrong Glen, P.C., continue with the design phase of the Kenilworth/Romany Storm Drainage Improvement Project. The project goal is to reduce street and structure flooding by improving storm drainage infrastructure.

Project update:

- Staff continues working with utility companies to resolve potential conflicts and concerns.
- Armstrong Glen submitted preliminary design plans for review by City Staff and utility companies. The initial review of those plans is wrapping up and comments will be provided to Armstrong Glen soon.

- A public meeting is tentatively planned for early summer to share the design details and request feedback as it relates to your property and the neighborhood.
