

YOUR STORM WATER FEES AT WORK

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and Dewberry Engineers have acquired the majority of easements and are working on the design plans. The permitting phase has begun. During this phase, the required water quality permits are obtained from Federal and State governments. These environmental permits are required by the Army Corps of Engineers.

The project goals are to reduce structure and street flooding throughout the neighborhood and stabilize streams.

## Waterways Need Plant Buffers

Buffers are trees, bushes, and deep rooted plants along a stream, pond, river or lake. They reduce property loss from erosion, support fish and wildlife, and improve water quality.

- Keep herbicides away.
