Charlotte Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and US Infrastructure have completed the final construction drawings and the restart of bid phase is next.

Next Steps:

During the bid phase, final design plans will be circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process. After City Council approval, the construction contract is awarded to the lowest responsible bidder. Construction will start at the downstream end of the project at Hawthorne Lane and CSXT Railroad.
