The project team is also working with utility companies to address relocation and design issues. This process will require the acquisition of additional utility easements. The project team is in the bid phase working to complete the construction documents. Once the bid phase is complete and City Council awards the contract, construction will begin.

The City repairs, replaces and installs new storm drainage infrastructure when it deteriorates or becomes too small to handle increases in stormwater. Investing in infrastructure protects public safety, guards private property, improves water quality and enhances quality of life.

The Louise Avenue Storm Drainage Improvement Project will reduce street and structure flooding throughout the neighborhood and address stream erosion to provide a more natural, stable stream system.
