All permits and easements have been acquired for construction and the project has begun the bid phase. At the end of this phase, competitive bids are taken from responsible contractors to perform the work. After City Council approval, the City awards the construction contract to the lowest responsible bidder. Bid phase typically takes six months and construction for this project is estimated to take two years.


