Dear Resident:

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and consulting engineer, Land Design, Inc., continue with the design phase for the Mary Alexander Storm Drainage Improvement Project. Design work includes locating utilities, verifying pipe clearances, creating computer generated maps and resolving any utility/pipe conflicts.

Preliminary design plans have been submitted by the consultant and are being reviewed by City staff. Once all preliminary plan comments have been addressed, the required water quality permits are obtained from Federal and State governments. Other permits such

as permission to work within Charlotte Mecklenburg Utility rights-of-way will also be obtained during this phase. The permitting phase typically lasts 3-9 months.



