Project Status:

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services is finalizing the design and easement acquisition phases of the Mary Alexander Storm Drainage Improvement Project. When acquisition is complete, the bid phase will begin.

Next Steps:

During the bid phase, the final plans will be circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process. After City Council approval, the construction contract is awarded to the lowest responsible bidder. The bid phase typically lasts 5 to 6 months.
