

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant, Parsons Brinckerhoff, Inc., are finalizing the construction plans. All easements and permits have been acquired.

The next step will be the bid phase. During this phase, the final design plans will be circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process. After City Council approval, the construction contract is awarded to the lowest responsible bidder.

Buffers are trees, bushes, and deep rooted plants along a stream, pond, river or lake. They reduce property loss from erosion, support fish and wildlife, and improve water quality.
