Dear Resident,

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant, Parsons Brinckerhoff, Inc., continue to work on the related environmental permits and finalize the construction plans.


The next step will be the bid phase. During this phase, the final plans will be circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process. By state law, the lowest responsible bidder is awarded the construction contract. The bid phase typically lasts 5 to 6 months, with construction to begin thereafter.
