**Project Status:**

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services is in the final stages of the design phase. A constructability review of the final design plans is underway, and a few minor revisions may be needed. Upon completion of the constructability review, the project will start the bid phase.

**Next Steps:**

During the bid phase, competitive bids are taken from responsible contractors to perform the work. After City Council approval, the City awards the construction contract to the lowest responsible bidder. The bid phase typically lasts 6 to 9 months.
