

This is being sent to all property owners and tenants along the Charlotte Myrtle Morehead Drainage Project and also various agencies. This is to provide you with a project update concerning two issues.

First. The tunnel construction continues. Blasting and excavation are both complete, but the tunnel is not nearly complete. The next step will be to deliver and lower the 90" concrete pipe into the shaft, and then place it into position in the tunnel-about 148' of pipe. After that, the void around the pipe in the tunnel will be filled with flowable concrete. In the attached photos, you will see the access shaft taken from Oriole Street looking down into the shaft, and another photo taken from the bottom of the shaft looking into the tunnel.

Second. A major traffic shift will be placed along Morehead Street beginning about 9:00am Monday April 20. Morehead traffic will be shifted into one lane in each direction. This traffic shift will begin Monday and be completed on Tuesday. Please note, southbound Morehead traffic will not be allowed to turn left onto McDowell Street. This will be in place for 30 days to allow Sanders to replace 80 ft. of 54" waterline that runs along Morehead Street. It may take traffic a few days to adjust, backups are expected. A notification has been sent by Charlotte DOT to emergency responders as well as various public agencies.
