Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services is investigating conditions for the Myrtle/Morehead Storm Drainage Improvement Project. Engineering consultant Woolpert North Carolina has been hired to analyze needs and design system improvements. The project boundaries are South Boulevard to the northwest, John Belk Freeway to the northeast and East Park Road to the south.

Woolpert is finalizing survey efforts and analyzing options for drainage improvements. Once the proposed improvements are selected you will be notified at least two weeks in advance of a public meeting to share project details.
