

This is being sent to all property owners and tenants along the Charlotte Myrtle Morehead Drainage Project and also various agencies. The scheduled project work continues at Oriole Street and also at Baxter/McDowell Streets. This email is to provide you with a project update concerning a leaking water main and necessary repairs.

An existing 16" City water line that runs along the East edge of Morehead Street (next to McDowell) has a leak and a small pothole in the pavement has developed. In order to repair the line, and simultaneously complete some project improvements, we will be closing some lanes on Morehead and McDowell Streets beginning Wednesday June 3, 2015 about 9:00am. The inbound (Southbound) lanes of Morehead will not be effected. Two (of three) Northbound Lanes of Morehead will be closed at McDowell Street, but all traffic movements will be available. Inbound McDowell Street will remain basically the same as it is now (one lane). Outbound McDowell Street will be narrowed to one lane at Morehead, but all traffic movements will be available.

The above traffic shifts will be in effect for about two weeks to repair the waterline and replace some of the valves. The leak has forced crews to quickly repair the waterline before a major break occurs. As usual, weather greatly impacts the scheduling. As a reminder, please keep alert to changing traffic patterns as you travel the work zone.

Please advise if you have any questions. I hope this information keeps you informed of the project's impacts on the area.
