

Hello Myrtle/Morehead Businesses and Residents:

The Myrtle/Morehead Storm Drainage Improvement Project (Phase 1) is well underway. Construction of the tunnel shaft (at Morehead and Oriole) is complete. Attached are a couple of photos taking during the construction of the shaft. The shaft is approximately 34 feet deep. With the shaft in, Bradshaw Construction (the tunneling subcontractor) is ready to tunnel underneath Morehead. At the other end of the project near Baxter Street, Sanders Utility Construction is forming the downstream structure that will connect the new pipe system to the existing.

Sanders Utility Construction and Bradshaw Construction intend to break for the holidays. This Friday is their last day working until Monday, January 5<sup>th</sup>. There will be someone inspecting the two construction areas periodically to check on things. If you notice anything needing attention, please do not hesitate to contact us.

Based upon feedback I have received from a couple of residents along Oriole Street and from Sanders, I propose we have a meeting to talk through some traffic and construction-related items. Just an informal meeting where we can answer questions and discuss and/or work through issues and concerns.
