Dear Resident:

Charlotte Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and its consultant engineer, Woolpert, are continuing with the design of the Myrtle/Morehead Storm Drainage Improvement Project. The project boundaries are South Boulevard to the northwest, John Belk Freeway to the northeast, and East Park Road to the south. The project goal is to improve storm drainage infrastructure and reduce flooding of streets and structures.

Project update includes:

- Staff and utilities have reviewed the preliminary design plans.
- Woolpert is revising the plans to address utility conflicts.
- Crews are collecting additional geotechnical information at McDowell and Morehead.

- Woolpert has identified easement needs and staff has begun working with property owners.
- The public meeting to show design plans, tentatively scheduled for this fall, will be held after the holidays. Look for meeting details in January.
