Dear Resident or Property Owner/Manager,

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services continues to work on the Parkwood Phase 1 Storm Drainage Improvement Project. The design plans have been finalized and most easement acquisition is complete.

The bid phase began in December 2013. During the bid phase, the final plans will be circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process. By state law, the lowest responsible bidder is awarded the construction contract. The bid phase typically lasts 6 months.

ROOTS

Roots anchor the soil, reduce flood damage and take up excess fertilizers.

Shade keeps the water cool, allowing fish and aquatic life to thrive.

Shaded streams provide valuable habitat for wildlife.
