Dear Resident or Property Owner,

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and consulting engineers RS&H are completing the evaluation of the existing conditions within the project area. When analysis is complete a public meeting will be scheduled to present the findings and solicit input from project area residents and property owners. Meeting details will be mailed to you approximately two weeks in advance.

The project is being split into two phases: Phase 1 is downstream of the proposed light rail extension. Work is being accelerated on Phase 1 to prepare for the light rail extension. Phase 2 is upstream of the light rail

extension and work will begin once Phase 1 is complete.
