Dear Resident or Property Owner/Manager,

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant, RS&H, continue with the design phase of the Parkwood Phase 1 Storm Drainage Improvement Project. This project will improve storm drainage infrastructure and reduce street and structure flooding. Channel improvements to the creek will also be made to increase capacity and reduce erosion.

During the design phase, RS&H will develop construction plans for the proposed storm drainage improvements. Once the preliminary construction plans are complete, we will hold a public meeting to

discuss the designed improvements and kickoff the easement acquisition phase. We expect to hold the public meeting within the next six months.
