Dear Resident,

Gulf Coast Property agents continue to work with property owners to finalize easements needed for construction. Once all easements are acquired, the construction drawings will be finalized and all permits obtained. The project will then begin the bid phase.

During this phase, competitive bids are taken from responsible contractors to perform the work. After City Council approval, the City awards the construction contract to the lowest responsible bidder. Bid phase typically takes six months.
