All easements needed for construction have been acquired, the construction drawings finished and necessary permits obtained from local and state agencies.

The bid phase has begun, during which final plans are circulated to qualified contractors for competitive bidding. After City Council approval, the construction contract is awarded to the lowest responsible bidder.

Construction is expected to begin this fall.

Buffers are trees, bushes, and deep rooted plants along a stream, pond, river or lake. They reduce property loss from erosion, support fish and wildlife, and improve water quality.

- Keep herbicides away.
