YOUR STORM WATER FEES AT WORK

Dear Resident,

The real estate phase continues for the Peterson Drive Storm Drainage Improvement Project. Gulf Coast Property agents will be contacting property owners if easements are needed to construct the proposed improvements. The project should be ready for the bid phase in December. During this phase, competitive bids are taken from responsible contractors to perform the work. After City Council approval, the City awards the construction contract to the lowest responsible bidder. Bid phase typically takes six months.

Construction is expected to begin in fall 2014.

Don't wash your car on your driveway or in the street. Soap suds flow to the nearest storm drain, then directly into the nearest creek. That could kill fish and other aquatic life.

Instead, park your car on your lawn to wash it. Or, better yet, take your car to a professional car wash where the water is cleaned. You'll have a clean car and all of us will have clean streams.
