Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and consulting engineer, HDR, are continuing with the design phase of the Princeton-Somerset Storm Drainage Improvement Project. During this phase, construction drawings and specifications are developed for the recommended improvements. City staff will conduct a public meeting early next year to present the preliminary construction documents and discuss easement acquisition needs. The goal of this project is to improve the storm drainage infrastructure and reduce flooding of streets and structures.
