Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services is finalizing the easement acquisition phase of the Princeton/Somerset Storm Drainage Improvement Project. When acquisitions are complete, and after the design engineer finishes the construction documents, the bid phase will begin. That phase typically lasts 5 to 6 months, with construction to begin thereafter.

Project managers work very hard to keep project costs down, including easement costs. The City requests that easements be donated to provide access to your property to make the recommended improvements and provide future maintenance. Continued support and cooperation is greatly appreciated.
