Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services is currently working with engineering consultant Hazen and Sawyer to study the existing conditions of the project area. Several different alternatives are being evaluated due to the confined nature of all the buildings in the area.

The project area borders Purser Drive to the north, Shamrock Drive to the south, Briar Creek to the east and Eastway Drive to the west.
