YOUR STORM WATER FEES AT WORK

Dear Resident:

Charlotte Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and its consultant engineer, USInfrastructure, are designing drainage improvements along Raleigh Street and Greensboro Street west of Sugar Creek Road. These improvements are being designed in coordination with Charlotte Area Transit Systems (CATS) Blue Line Extension Project.

We have collected survey and geotechnical information, met with the different utility companies, and prepared preliminary design plans. The majority of the work proposed is located in the roadway; however, we will need easements on some of the properties.

Real Estate agents representing the City are in the process of contacting and working with those property owners.
