Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services held its second public meeting for the Wanamassa Storm Drainage Improvement Project on November 13, 2014, at Beatties Ford Road Public Library. The purpose of the meeting was to present the proposed storm drainage improvements.

Meeting highlights:

- Project Manager Chad Nussman introduced the project team and thanked residents for their attendance.
- Mr. Nussman presented the proposed culvert sizes and channel improvements at Wanamassa Drive, Saquache Drive, Lola Drive, Garvin Drive and the school driveway culverts.
- Mr. Nussman assured residents the project team will work closely with City Landscape Management to save as many trees as possible during construction. He noted that due to channel widening, some trees along the existing top of bank may need to be removed.

- Mr. Nussman described the project phases:
 - ♦ Design
 - ♦ Permitting
 - ♦ Easement Acquisition
 - ♦ Bid and Award
 - ♦ Construction
- A question and answer session was held.
