Wanamassa Storm Drainage Improvement Project

Some questions and answers from the public meeting

Q: When will construction start?

A: Construction is estimated to start spring of 2018. However, several variables can affect the project timeline. Some include property owner cooperation with respect to easements, public and private utility coordination, permitting agency review and other project stakeholder reviews.

Q: Will there be any grading downstream of the Garvin Drive culvert?

A: Construction downstream of Garvin Drive should be limited to channel grading required to install the culvert.

Q: Will Garvin Drive be closed during construction?

A: Yes, Garvin Drive will be closed while the culvert is installed. In fact, Lola Drive, Saquache Drive and Wanamassa Drive will be closed while each successive culvert is installed. While this may be inconvenient the neighborhood's connectivity should minimize traffic impacts.

Q: When will construction begin at Wanamassa Drive?

A: The proposed culvert at Wanamassa Drive will be the last constructed since storm water improvements are constructed from downstream to the upstream end of the system. Periodic updates will be mailed to residents during construction and a City Construction Inspector will be onsite to answer questions and address concerns.
