Dear Resident:

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and Mulkey Engineers & Consultants continue to work on the design phase for the Water Oak Storm Drainage Improvement Project. Mulkey has submitted the preliminary design plans and is currently being reviewed by City staff from multiple departments. The preliminary design plans were also sent to all utility companies in the area (AT&T, Duke Energy, Time Warner, Piedmont Natural Gas, etc.), and a field meeting was held to coordinate possible utility conflicts.

The proposed improvements include culvert replacement, stream stabilization, storm drain

improvements and utility relocations. The goals of the project are to replace failing infrastructure, reduce flooding of streets and structures and reduce erosion along the stream and channel.


