Project Status:

The Alternative Analysis Report has been completed and the City has evaluated the different alternatives. Taking into account public safety, private property impacts and project costs, a recommended alternative was identified. The recommended alternative is typically a combination and/or variation of improvements from the City Design Standard and the other alternatives.

Next Steps:

USI Infrastructure of Carolina, Inc. is working on analyzing the recommended alternative. Once this is complete, a public meeting will be scheduled to present the recommended alternative to residents. Meeting details will be mailed to residents two weeks in advance.
