





## HOURS OF OPERATION

<b>Monday – Thursday</b>	<b>6am – 11pm</b>
<b>Friday</b>	<b>6am – 12am</b>
<b>Saturday</b>	<b>8am – 12am</b>
<b>Sunday</b>	<b>9am – 7pm</b>





- **Stay Alert! Listen for whistles, bells or horns.**
- **Streetcars cannot stop quickly, are on rails, and cannot swerve out of the way of vehicles and pedestrians.**
- **Streetcars traveling at 16 mph take almost 100 feet to stop.**

- Obey all signs, signals and laws.
- Do not pass a stopped streetcar.
- Follow the streetcar at a safe distance
- Be alert for people entering and exiting the streetcar at all times.





- **STOP, LOOK and LISTEN.**  
Streetcars will be traveling in both directions.
- **Obey all traffic and pedestrian signs, signals and laws.**
- **Cross only at designated crosswalks.**
- **Step over tracks to avoid catching shoe heels in the track gap.**
- **Wait for the streetcar behind the yellow warning strip on platforms.**





ALWAYS CROSS TRACKS AT  
**90° ANGLE**



- Avoid getting your wheels stuck. Cross tracks at a right angle, or just walk your bicycle across.
- Wet tracks can be slippery.
- Cross to stop platforms only at designated crossings.
- Never stop on the tracks.




# Do Not Place Objects on Tracks
