




MOVING CHARLOTTE FORWARD

Blue Line Extension: Northeast Corridor

LYNX Blue Line Extension Construction Street Closure: Raleigh St, south of Greensboro St March 3, 2016 thru Fall 2016

- Due to construction, Raleigh Street, just south of Greensboro Street and continuing to Sugar Creek Road
- Will be limited to Local Traffic Only.
- During this closure, access to businesses will remain available from Sugar Creek Road.
- No thru traffic will be able to travel from the Greensboro intersection to Raleigh Road.
- Thru traffic will be able to use Greensboro Street between Sugar Creek Road and Craighead Road.
- Local access to residences and businesses will be maintained.
- CATS will not be affected.

Weather and unforeseen circumstances occasionally prevent work from being completed as scheduled, and make it unsafe to reopen lanes or streets when planned. When this occurs, City traffic engineers work directly with other City staff and contractors to resolve the situation as quickly as possible and reduce impacts to the traveling public.

Pedestrians walking near work zone areas should be alert, cautious and allow extra traveling time. It is advised they cross at signalized intersections, use pedestrian walk signals where available and abide by detour signage.

Motorists traveling through work zone areas should be alert and extra cautious. Drivers should get in the correct lane well in advance and constantly be on the lookout for vehicles merging into adjacent travel lanes as they approach a work zone. Drivers should double their following distance.
