


CENSUS 2010 Population Profile: Town of Cornelius



*Hispanic or Latino Origin--This category is not included in the total since persons of Hispanic or Latino origin may be of any race.

Key Points:

- While still the majority, White population as a proportion of the town's total population declined from 91.6% in 2000 to 88.3% in 2010.
- African American population, which accounted for 5.6% of total population in 2000 now makes up 5.8% of the town's residents.
- Asian population, which made up 1.2% of the city's total in 2000 now accounts for 2.3% of Cornelius total population.
- People of Hispanic or Latino origin now comprise 5.3% of the town's total population, compared to 2.8% in 2000.

Key Points:

- In the last decade Cornelius grew by 24,866, a growth rate of 107.8%.
- Whites saw the largest increase of 10,978 people.
- African Americans saw the second largest population gain of 772.
- Asian population increased from 1.2% to 2.3% between 2000 and 2010, this is a percent change of 278.4%.
- Hispanic population grew by 993 to 5.3% of the population in 2010 from 2.8% in 2000.
