


CENSUS 2010 Population Profile: Town of Pineville



*Hispanic or Latino Origin--This category is not included in the total since persons of Hispanic or Latino origin may be of any race.

Key Points:

-While still the majority, White population as a proportion of the town's total population declined from 80.1% in 2000 to 62.1% in 2010.

-African American population, which accounted for 10% of total population in 2000 now makes up 22.2% of the town's residents.

-Asian population, which made up 3.3% of the town's total in 2000 now accounts for 3.4% of Pineville's total population.

-People of Hispanic or Latino origin now comprise 20.1% of the town's total population, compared to 11.2% in 2000.

Key Points:

- In the last decade Pineville grew by 4,030, a growth rate of 116.8%.
- Whites saw the largest increase of 1,880 people.
- African Americans saw the second largest population gain of 1,319.
- Asian population increased from 3.3% to 3.4% between 2000 and 2010, this is a percent change of 126.3%
- Hispanic population grew by 1,122 to 20.1% of total population in 2010 from 11.2% in 2000.
