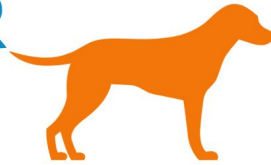

Live Release Rate Formula:

$$\text{Live Release Rate} = 1 - \left[\frac{(\text{Total Non-Live Outcomes}) - (\text{Owner Requested Euthanasia}) - (\text{Died})}{(\text{Total Intake}) + (\text{Beginning Animal Count}) - (\text{Ending Animal Count}) - (\text{Died})} \right] * 100$$

*** Died is taken out from both the numerator and denominator as the majority of animals that are taken out of the system as "Died" did so before arriving at the CMPD AC&C shelter. Each animal that dies in care undergoes a case review by division management. ***
