



A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING May 16, 1960

ON A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE. (North side Huntley Place,  
east of Providence Road).

WHEREAS, at the meeting of the City Council on April 11, 1960

the following amendment to the City Code was introduced:

"Ordinance No. 668. An Ordinance Amending Chapter 21 of the City  
Code - Zoning Ordinance

An Ordinance Amending the City Code with Respect to the Zoning Ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

Section 1. That Chapter 21, Article I, Section 2, of the City Code  
of the City of Charlotte, (O. B. 10) be amended by having Building  
Zone Map of the City of Charlotte amended by changing from Residence 1  
to Residence 2 the following described property:

BEGINNING at a point in the northerly margin of Huntley Place,  
said point being located S. 75-19 E. 285.0 feet from the inter-  
section of the northerly margin of Huntley Place with the east-  
erly margin of Providence Road and running thence with said  
margin of Huntley Place S. 75-19 E. 140.29 feet to an old iron;  
thence N. 13-23-40 E. 134.25 feet to an old iron; thence N. 77-05-20  
W. 133.0 feet, more or less, to an existing Business 1 Zoning Dis-  
trict boundary line; thence with said boundary line in a southerly  
direction 62 feet, more or less, to a point in the westerly boundary  
line of property belonging to Mrs. Beverly H. Flinn; thence with  
said boundary line S. 13-10-50 W. 70 feet, more or less, to the  
BEGINNING.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its adop-  
tion after a public hearing in connection therewith."

AND, WHEREAS, under the law no amendment to the zoning ordinance can be adopted  
until a public hearing thereon is held, of which public hearing notice is re-  
quired to be given publication not less than fifteen days immediately preceding  
the date of such hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

1. That May 16, 1960 at 2 o'clock P.M. be fixed as  
the time, and the Council Chamber in the City Hall as the place for the public  
hearing on the proposed amendment as above set out.

WHEREAS, at the meeting of the City Council on April 11, 1960, the  
following amendment to the City Code was introduced:

"Ordinance No. 670. An Ordinance Amending Chapter 21 of the  
City Code - Zoning Ordinance.

An Ordinance Amending the City Code with Respect to the Zoning Ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

Section 1. That Chapter 21, Article I, Section 2, of the City Code  
of the City of Charlotte, (O. B. 10), be amended by having Building  
Zone Map of the City of Charlotte amended by changing from Residence 2  
to Business 1 the following described property:

BEING all of Lots 1-6 in Block 3 and Lots 1-6 in Block 6 as shown  
on a map of Piedmont Park recorded in Book 146, Page 206 in the  
office of the Register of Deeds for Mecklenburg County, N. C.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption  
after a public hearing in connection therewith."

AND, WHEREAS, under the law no amendment to the zoning ordinance can be adopted  
until a public hearing thereon is held, of which public hearing notice is re-  
quired to be given publication not less than fifteen days immediately preceding  
the date of such hearing;
